DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Preparation of Disinfection/Fungicidal, Virucidal* Use Solution:

- 1. For heavily soiled areas, a precleaning step is required.
- 2. Add 1 oz. BUCKEYE WATCHDOG NF per gallon of water to disinfect hard, nonporous surfaces. Apply use-solution using a cloth, mop, sponge, sprayer, automatic scrubber, or by immersion so as to thoroughly wet surfaces.
- 3. Rub with brush, sponge or cloth. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes.
- 4. Rinse or allow to air dry. Rinse all surfaces that come in contact with food with potable water before re-use.

Veterinary Clinics/Breeding Facilities/Zoos/Pet Shops/ Kennels and Grooming Establishments Disinfection Directions:

- Remove all animals and feeds from areas being treated.
- 2. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls and surfaces.
- 3. Empty all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering appliances.
- 4. Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap and detergent, and rinse with water.
- 5. Appy a use solution of 1 oz. of this product per 1 gallon of water so as to wet thoroughly. Apply by cloth, mop, brush, sponge, automatic scrubber, mechanical spray device or by immersion. For spray applications, spray 6-8 inches from surface. Do not breathe spray. Rub with brush, cloth, or by sponge. Allow surfaces to remain wet for a period of 10 minutes.
- 6. For Canine Parvovirus saturate all hard, nonporous surfaces with a use-solution of 4 oz. of BUCKEYE WATCHDOG NF per gallon of water for a period of 10 minutes.
- 7. Immerse all halters and other hard, nonporous equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels and scrapers used in removing litter and manure.
- 8. Ventilate buildings and other closed spaces.
- 9. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.
- 10. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, automatic feeders, waterers and other treated equipment that dispenses food or water with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water before re-use.
- 11. Change cloth, sponge or towels frequently to avoid redeposition of soil. Prepare a fresh solution at least daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.
