DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Treatment

Dust mops or cloths may be treated by several methods:

Method 1: Spray evenly over the the mop surface with a spray bottle. Fluff the strands of the mop, and spray again. Periodic single sprayings of the mop will revitalize the dust pick-up ability. If the mop glazes or becomes too dirty, it should be laundered.

Method 2: In a container large enough to hold mops or cloths, mix Aqua Dust 43 fl. oz./gallon water (333 ml/l), (1:3) and totally immerse articles until thoroughly wetted. Wring out excess and allow to dry for 24 hours before use.

Laundering

When the mops or cloths become soiled, they should be placed in an "open net" laundry bag or wrapped and tied in single layer of cheese-cloth and simply washed through a household or commercial washer. Under normal conditions, the self-laundering action of **Aqua Dust** will require no additional laundry detergent.
