DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Shake well before and during use.
- 2. Test surface to be cleaned for possible changes in color or texture before use.
- 3. Do not spray painted surfaces.
- 4. Hold can UPSIDE DOWN 6–10 inches from surface to be sprayed. Cover surface with a thin, even coating. Wipe off any over-spray immediately.
- 5. Wait 3–5 minutes (longer in case of severe buildup).
- 6. Scrub with a doodle bug pad or stripping pad.
- 7. Rinse with clean water.
