# DIRECTIONS

#### **Directions for Screening:**

- 1. Dust mop floor to remove grit and debris. Remove any gum and tape.
- 2. Apply Screen Clean to the floor using an EZ-Way applicator, sprinkling can or mop and bucket. Wet a section approximately 200 square feet.
- 3. Screen with a rotary swing machine equipped with white or red pad and #120 grit screen. Soak all new screens with Screen Clean prior to use. The white pad helps hold the screen to the pad driver. Scrub the 200 square foot area twice (once moving north/south going slowly with the boards, then a second pass going east/west – you can move faster on this pass). As you're screening, overlap the previous pass by half the width of the screen in order to avoid missing any areas.
- 4. Pick up the dirty solution and rinse well. Wet vacuums and mops and buckets can be used; however, an autoscrubber filled with plain water and equipped with a red or blue pad works much better.
- 5. Wet the next 200 square foot section, flip the screen over and repeat the process (one scrub north/south, again east/west).
- 6. For the next 200 square foot section, begin with a fresh screen. Each screen is good for 400 square feet (200 per side).
- 7. If you have an autoscrubber, after the entire floor has been screened and rinsed, scrub rinse the entire floor once more with plain water – use blue or red pads.
- 8. Finally tack entire floor using white cotton bath towels moistened with Screen Clean.
- 9. Allow floor to dry thoroughly.
- 10. Apply the Buckeye Reflections® coating according to manufacturers instructions.

#### Directions for Tacking:

To clean floor and/or to fix slippery floors:

- 1. Soak a white cotton bath towel with Screen Clean.
- 2. Wring out until no longer dripping.
- 3. Wrap around a clean push broom and push across the floor.
- 4. Re-position the broom to different areas of the towel after each pass, and flip the towel after one side is dirty.
- 5. Change out to a clean towel as needed.
- 6. Allow floor to dry completely before resuming play or before recoating floor.
